He discovered that I needed four surgeries...two on my elbows and two on my back feet because they were missing some bones. The surgeries are expensive. Given the medical aspect of my rare malformation, The DMV Foundation supported me for some of the cost and my mom, with the help from people at the Foundation, has come up with the rest of the money!



To date, I have had my first two operations, those for the elbows. I'm recovering very quickly! I will soon undergo another operation: the one for the reconstruction of my two hind legs. I'm sure everything will go well: I was born under a lucky star. My human family loves me and takes good care of me and a special medical team gives me the best care possible! What more can I expect!
